Saturday, 9:00 a.m. – Meet at the downtown plaza
3 to 4 Easy Miles – Moderate Pace

Join us and explore the trees of Sebastopol with a focus on evergreens—both broad-leaved and conifer. We will depart the Plaza at 9:00, walk at a good pace to the bike path near Analy High, stopping at specific locations to identify trees in gardens and public spaces. A plant list will be provided.

Walkers will be introduced to many tree species: heritage trees, California natives, Sebastopol natives, and introduced varieties.

Plant “geek” and former Plant Identification teacher, Virginia Anderegg, will share easy ways to identify trees. We will cover 3 to 4 miles with several planned stops to identify and appreciate the rich flora of our town, and return to the Plaza by 11:30.

Wear sunscreen, a hat and walking shoes. Bring water and a snack.
